- Additional external websites which contain a one-stop-shop consisting of FAQ's and 'resolution matrix's'
- Videos (all available in its respective language)

➤ How does the solution work?

- This basic portal we are trying to build aims to be adapted further to accommodate different immigration systems
- [Questionnaire](#): to identify the clients' objectives - where they are and which country they are trying to relocate to; they will be redirected to the relevant immigration application portals
- Create a portal that automates documents that are generally required for specific visa application
- [Doc Automation](#) - to provide clients with 'explanation' templates for the provision of additional info e.g. missing IDs
- [Self service assistance](#) - for clients to upload relevant governmental documents, so lawyers can keep track of the status
- Additional external websites (to include lawyers and legal organisations we are partnered with)
- [FAQs](#): to screen clients who have more general queries and straightforward application cases
- Videos: 'How to videos', 'Direct translated videos'
- One on general introduction on the FAQs page
- one on step-by-step application guide within the portal
