

# **Streamlining your precious efforts**

## **Delivering help when needed, the way it's needed**

### **Pain**

Ukrainian migrants face unprecedented uncertainty, venturing into the unknown in foreign countries. People want to help, but they don't know exactly how to do that and how to team up with the right people to combine their efforts and help Ukrainian migrants benefit from a smooth transition to their new lives.

We are trying to solve that by creating a help forum where every stakeholder can participate and make an impactful contribution to solving migrants' needs in real time.

### **Product**

A database with an intuitive interface which can be accessed by all the relevant stakeholders involved: refugees themselves, border control, immigration lawyers, medical services providers, schools. It can be accessed through an app, or otherwise through the internet.

The interface will be divided into 2 sections: one for the helpers and one for those seeking help.

Refugees register their full names, profession, age and their immediate need. The app can outline the stages that a refugee has to go through (i.e. starting from leaving the country, migrating to the desired country, accessing any medical services they need, finding accommodation, employment, schooling for children etc.).

The app/website should have an option (subject to confidentiality/data protection regulations) for migrants to submit ID/document evidence for border control and immigration lawyers to process online, in advance of even reaching the border/office so that things can progress quickly.

Refugees should just click on what they need and then tick a box once their problem is sorted.

### **Business/Charity Model**

Service/accommodation providers can log on and see notifications about who needs what. As soon as they provide any help, they earn points which add up and which will eventually earn them status as a helper in the form of a token. This token should come with some rewards for the top providers (something akin to Which awards, but for aid/charity),

anything from discounts to sponsoring companies to the possibility of turning it into an NFT which can be traded.
