- Auto-translation of text-text, speech-text, text-speech, speech-speech


Other points


- Market app via QR code that redirects to app store

Automatically detect OS language and default to it using Google API translation of in-app text














Prebuilt list of common categories of assistance such as food, housing, legal which lead to Google Maps lookups
